

The UL Lafayette Science Museum welcomes visitors of all ages and offers informative and entertaining exhibits to the community. We strive to create an environment of mutual respect and civility to provide a safe and enjoyable experience for all. To maintain these standards, we provide the following Code of Conduct.

- Respect others. Be courteous to others around you by using your “inside voices” throughout the Museum at all times.
- Always walk, never run indoors. No climbing. Please stay behind all barriers.
- Children under 10 must be under the constant supervision of an adult caregiver at all times. Adults must immediately report any emergency or child separated from the group to a Museum staff member.
- The Museum is tobacco-free. Using, possessing, or being under the influence of alcohol or illegal drugs is prohibited.
- Weapons of any kind are not allowed on the premises.
- Respect elevator usage. Please keep elevators open for visitors who are not able to use the stairs. If you are able to use stairs, please do so.
- Respect bathrooms. It is everyone’s responsibility to keep the bathrooms clean. Please do not use the restrooms to play. Spraying or splashing water, plugging toilets, sinks etc. in the bathroom is wasteful and unacceptable behavior that may be viewed as vandalism. Place paper towels in the trash cans.
- One adult chaperone is required for every 10 students. Chaperones and teachers are to help students engage with the Museum and supervise their behavior. Chaperones must remain with their group at all times. Cell phone usage is discouraged during the time spent in the Museum.
- No gum chewing, food, or drinks are allowed in exhibition halls. Dispose of all your trash in trash cans.

Any museum visitor not following the Code of Conduct guidelines will be asked to leave the Museum. If asked to leave, entrance fees will be forfeited and future visits may be denied. All visitors, including teachers and students, must comply with directions of the Museum employees. Thank you for your cooperation.
